The Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection (KDEP) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have reviewed the Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD)'s letter, dated December 21, 2015, requesting approval of a minor project modification to the Fairmount Road Pump Station and SSO Storage Basin, IOAP Project No. S\_FF\_CC\_81316-M\_03\_C\_A as set forth in MSD's Integrated Overflow Abatement Plan (IOAP). The requested modification seeks an extension to the project completion date from December 31, 2015, to March 31, 2016 due to weather-related delays.

The proposed project modification is hereby approved and the new completion date will supersede and replace the project completion date listed in the IOAP under the same title and IOAP Project Numbers. This project modification is thus integrated into the IOAP as an enforceable requirement of the Amended Consent Decree in accordance with Paragraphs 25.a.(3) and 25.b.(2) therein.

This project modification does not significantly alter the requirements of the IOAP, and we therefore agree that such change is a non-material modification to the Amended Consent Decree pursuant to Paragraph 60 of the Amended Consent Decree. Please note that it will be
