
Draft Cul-de-sac Access Plan (CSO 104/105)

What's going on with Hornung Field?

At Shawnee Park, located in Louisville, Kentucky you'll find Hornung Field. The field was named after NTL Hall of Famer running back, Paul Hornung, who attended High School directly across the street at Flaget High School, Hornung was the school's star athlete and quarterback of the football team. When his team won the state championship, Hornung was named most valuable player and recruiters from across the country started knocking at his door. Hornung received a scholarship from Norte Dame and joined the Flighting Irisk. While attending Notre Dame he played basketball and football.

Paul Hornung played for the Green Bay Packers from 1957 to 1966, where his team won four NFL titles and the first Super Bowlin 1967. He's the first pro footballer in history to win the Heisman Trophy, be selected as the first overall selection in the NFL Draft, win



the professional and college football Halls of Fame.


