In a typical year, excessive rainfall causes more than 350 million gallons of sewage and rainwater to combine and pollute local waterways.

Severe rainfall events are predicted to become more numerous in the future.

The federal government mandated that Louisville capture and treat 98 percent of combined sewer overflow volume by 2024.

THE FACTS

The MSD Waterway Protection Tunnel

- 18 stories underground that is half the height of Louisville's tallest building
- 20 ft diameter x 2.5 miles long
- 2 years of construction
