Thank you for taking the time to submit your comments relative to Camp Taylor Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project. Your comments are summarized below, and your e-mail (dated August 14, 2012) has been attached for reference.

1) <u>Comment</u> – The sanitary sewer that is supposed to be installed along Lee Avenue in Camp Taylor, is it to be installed in the street or in the yards?

<u>Response to comment</u> – The final alignment for these proposed sewers has not been set, however it is the intention of MSD to construct all new sewers within the existing right-of-way.

2) <u>Comment</u> – What dates will the work on the project begin and end?

<u>Response to comment</u> – The start of construction is anticipated near the end of this year, and construction is expected to last approximately twelve to fifteen months. Actual dates will not be set until the contract is awarded.
