Dear

Thank you for taking the time to submit your comments relative to Camp Taylor Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project. Your written and verbal comments are summarized below, and your comment form has been attached for reference.

<u>Written comment</u> – Sanitary line under my property – need to ask question – concerning.

<u>Verbal comment</u> – The resident at Belmar Drive had a concrete truck brought in to pour a patio on their property on August 10, 2012. Since the existing sanitary sewer line serving Indiana Avenue runs under the location the concrete truck had to travel, there are concerns regarding possible damage to the sanitary sewer line.

Response to comment – Service Request was initiated based on your call at 1:40PM on August 10, 2012. An MSD inspector determined at that time the sanitary sewer line is deep enough that the concrete truck should not have had a negative impact. If, at any time, a discharge or blockage is observed, please call MSD Customer Relations at (502) 563-6387 to report the problem.

The sewer segment in question will be abandoned during the construction of new sewers in the area. A Property Service Connection (PSC) serving only your property will be installed and connected to a new sewer line in Indiana Avenue. This will potentially alleviate future problems arising from improvements on adjacent properties.




